### Richard Gibson–TRGS Geology Field Course Award for Excellence

Schools conducting university-level field-oriented capstone geology courses are eligible to nominate **one student per course per year** for this award. Courses must be conducted primarily within the TRGS area of interest, the Northern Rocky Mountains. Nominations must come from a field course director or the professor primarily responsible for the course. One award will be made per year.

The award will consist of a certificate, listing on the TRGS web site and TRGS publications, and a cash prize of \$250 funded by Richard Gibson.

To nominate a top-performing student, please provide the following information to the TRGS:



- Student name, contact information
- School name, nominator's contact information
- A brief description of the field course
- Narrative explanation supporting the student's nomination, not to exceed two pages, with focus on performance in the field course; may include recommendation from nominator
- Simplified resume outlining noteworthy achievements in geoscience in addition to field course performance

Criteria: Awards will be based on evidence of a student's technical ability, independence, creativity, improvement, general understanding, and likelihood to continue in a geoscience profession.

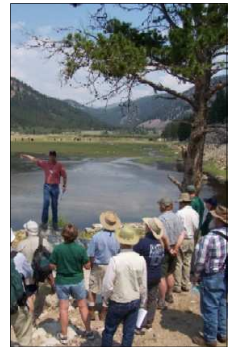
### Richard Gibson–TRGS Geology Field Course Award for Excellence
